

The following is an excerpt from an email received by FreedomLift from Mr. Louis Gagliardi, CEO of WorldWide Wireless, Inc. and owner of the FreedomLift on his Silverton 390 MY. Mr. Gagliardi writes:

...I also wanted to let you know that I recently returned from a 4 week boat trip. My family and I went to Mackinaw Island. We had a fantastic time!!! The FreedomLift worked excellent! We stopped at 19 different ports and we used the dingy at 15 of them. The "freedom" the FreedomLift gave us added a whole different dimension to our trip that would not have happened had I not had the FreedomLift. The name of your product makes so much more sense after purchasing it and using it!! Four of the ports we went to we used the dingy to get there saving fuel and letting us see more up close the inland lakes off Lake Michigan. My wife even commented how nice it was to be able to get in the dingy and explore. We took it directly under the Mackinaw Bridge and took photos and swam under the Bridge - it was great!!

I also had several people staring as I easily with a push of a button lowered the dingy into and out of the water. Several asked me questions - even the guys with boats that had a dingy who used an arm to lower it into the water. It is sooooo much easier to just drop it off the back and take off. I really feel people don't use their dingy as much because it's just too much work to get it off the top of their boat - not to mention if it's even possible to do when you have a boat right next to you! One guy who had just a set-up came right out and asked me how much I paid. I kindly referred him to you and told him how nice it was to deal with you.

Finally, I did see another type of product out there that I won't mention but it looked way more difficult to use than the FreedomLift. I also like having the extra room the dingy afforded me because it was at a level I could reach and right behind the boat. I stored my kids fishing poles (they caught a ton of fish!!) and tackle box and some extra fenders in the dingy - leaving the big boat cleaner and easier to get around. The best part about the lift is it is a one man show. I am able to put it down and up easily all by myself. I drop my wife and kids off and I spend 5 to 10 minutes securely attaching the dingy - its way easier on the whole family! I did see a couple other boats with the FreedomLift and we all agreed it works very well - we all had that bond that we knew we made a good choice, thanks for a great product.

P.S. The other FreedomLift owners said your service was excellent also! Keep up the good work! Oh and there's plenty of room left on my swim platform to easily walk and get around even with my dingy there.
